Teresa Coon called the meeting to order at 5:15 P.M. with the following board members present: Hotchkin, Hartz, Meyer, and Lease.

Ben Latimer presented the design of the monument sign. Lease moved and Coon seconded approving the sign's content as presented, subject to further refinement of donor names. The motion carried unanimously.

Tom Lacina reported that the monument is scheduled to arrive in multiple semi loads on May 11 and to be assembled that week. Lighting will be added. The monument may or may not be ready for lighting on Memorial Day.

The dedication plans for July 4 were briefly discussed. No changes from prior planning. The event will occur at 7 pm with a dedication by the mayor and receipt of the monument on behalf of the veterans by Randy. Consideration is being given as to commemorative items for the 4th of July event that could be kept by participants and veterans.

The commission adjourned at about 5:45 pm to travel to the monument site and view the location first hand.
